Historical/Biographical Notes

Ethel Turner was born on February 8, 1901 in Worcester. She was the daughter of William T. Turner, a carpet weaver, and his wife Ellen who had both immigrated to the United States from England in the 1890's. In 1903, the Turner family moved to Denver, Colorado because they believed the climate would be milder on Mr. Turner's asthma, but a lack of work caused the family to return to Worcester in 1907. They moved into a house at 1 New York St., near the Whittall Mills where Mr. Turner had found a job, and where Ethel, her parents and Sister Rosa lived for the remainder of her school days. Although she had begun first grade in Denver, the family's departure meant she only spent a few months enrolled there, so Turner began her time in the Worcester Public School system in the spring of 1908 at Webster Square School. After competing fourth grade in 1911, she moved on to the Freeland Street School for the fifth and sixth grade. After scoring high marks there, she was able to attend the New Woodland Street Preparatory School for seventh and eighth grades, graduating in 1915. After this, Turner attended South High School for two years, before transferring to the High School of Commerce, where she could learn the skills needed to work in an office. After graduating in 1919, she found employment in the office of the Superintendent of Schools. She left in 1925 to marry George Bates Edwards.

Scope and Content

The collection includes numerous examples of class notes, schoolwork and some essays completed by Turner from the first grade in 1908 through her senior year in high school in 1919, pertaining to subjects such as English, mathematics, social studies, foreign languages, sciences, art and music as well as bookkeeping, stenography, economics and commercial law from her time at the High School of Commerce. Also included are report cards showing classes offered in Worcester's high school curriculum at the time, as well as short personal narratives by Edwards, Ethel Turner, about her early life and education.

In addition to her personal academic performance, the report cards from high school show the range of courses offered to students at the time.

1	8	1985.31	This folder contains fifth grade work from the Freeland Street School, including an apron made in order to practice sewing, geometric and nature drawings, and a project showing the growth of a seed into a leaf. In addition, it holds examples of arithmetic and geometry exercises, grammar exercises, letter writing practice, spelling exercises and a reading list with brief book reviews.
1	9	1985.31	This folder contains sixth grade work from Freeland Street School, including arithmetic practice work, spelling exercises, grammar practice work, short writing composition exercises, letter writing practice examples and a brief book review.
1	10	1985.31	This folder contains sixth grade work from Freeland Street School, including exercises on political, economic and physical geography in the western hemisphere , US and European history work, as well as a short personal history by Ethel.
1	11	1985.31	This folder contains sixth grade work from Freeland Street School, including miscellaneous drawings, music notation exercises, and a scrapbook of magazine or catalog cutouts called "Furnishing the Home."

2	12	1985.31	This folder contains seventh grade work from New Woodland Prep, including spelling practice work, letter writing practice exercises, dictation practice exercises, short writing compositions, arithmetic practice work and personal account keeping practice exercises. Also included are European and US history work, European and US geography exercises, and notes on civics.
2	13	1985.31	This folder contains seventh grade work from New Woodland Prep, including Latin language practice work, German language practice work, geometric drawings and an imaginative and memory test.
2	14	1985.31	This folder contains eighth grade work from New Woodland Prep, including grammar practice work, letter writing practice exercises, spelling exercises work, dictation exercises and short writing compositions. Also inside are arithmetic and algebra practice work.
2	15	1985.31	This folder contains eighth grade work from New Woodland prep, including US geography and civics work, Latin language practice exercises and German language work. Also included are physiology notes and music notes. Lastly there is a typed letter describing the students of the New Woodland Prep class of 1915.

The first contains English language work, including grammar notes, book or article reviews, spelling exercises, short writing compositions and letter writing practice exercises. The second notebook contains botany notes, along with a large number of pressed leaves.
2	19	1985.31	This folder contains work from sophomore year at South High, including geometry notes, a US history notebook containing material through the Civil War, Spanish language notes and verb conjugation practice exercises, and an advance lessons planning notebook.

are a series of lecture or reading notes on Robert Burns, notes on Washington's Farewell Address, military training in schools, the life of Lowell, the life of Luther Burbank and education in South America.

| 3 | 23 | 1985.31 | This folder contains work from junior year at the High School of Commerce in the subject of stenography. It includes practice typing exercises, notes on shorthand, and examples of shorthand practice. |
| 3 | 24 | 1985.31 | This folder contains two notebooks from the High School of Commerce. The smaller one contains Physiology notes, while the larger contains notes on U.S. history, commercial law, economics, typing and stenography. |
| 3 | 25 | 1985.31 | This folder contains work from senior year at the High School of Commerce. It includes US history notes, an Ivanhoe Historical Notebooks Series map book on US historical geography, economics notes economics exercises, and a banking assignment. Also included is a practice job application letter and an essay on what civilians can do to help during World War One. |
