Abstract : Collection of family photographs, Worcester views, etc., unknown family, located in Worcester from Rochester, N.Y., later removed to Nashua, N.H.

Historical/Biographical Notes

Family located in Worcester from Rochester, N.Y. in the early 1920s, later removed to Nashua, N.H. Family name is unknown from any identification on snapshots. During their stay in Worcester, the family lived in several locations in the city, and for a period had an English girl, Eva Sutcliffe, living with them.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises snapshots taken during the 1920s of various homes, Elm Park and other local scenes, family members, Wachusett Reservoir at Clinton dam, and miscellaneous snapshots. Included are snapshots of Eva Sutcliffe Hurst and family, a family friend in England.
