Historical/Biographical Notes

William Filene, a German immigrant, operated several stores in eastern New England between 1849 and 1881. In 1881 he opened a store in Boston selling women's clothing and accessories, and by 1890 expanded into a five-story building with basement, the largest store in Boston devoted to women's wear. William Filene retired after opening the new store, turning the business over to his sons, Edward and Lincoln. By 1912 annual sales amounted to \$4,500,000. The store continued to expand in Boston, adding a men's clothing department in 1912. In 1923 Filene's began opening branch stores throughout Massachusetts. The 100,000 square foot Worcester branch of Filene's opened in 1928 and closed in the 1970s, with the opening of a new Filene's in Auburn Mall. Filene's remains one of the leading department stores in Massachusetts.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of policies relating to Filene's Bargain basement, responsibilities of store managers, and publicity, all ca. 1920s. In addition the collection includes a history of Filene's, written by Stacy Holmes ca. 1960s.
