#### **Collection Information**

<u>Abstract</u>: The Alfred Jaynes Collection is comprised primarily of photographs of family members and scenes, and provides insight into the lives and activities of Mr. Jaynes and his family..

#### **Biographical/Historical Information**

Alfred F. Jaynes was a resident of Worcester from the 1940s or earlier until his death in the 1990s. He is first listed in the City Directory in 1944, employed as a porter, resident of Parker Street. No listing is available in the early 1950s, and it is assumed that he was with the armed services in Korea. He is again listed as a porter in 1953 and subsequent years, and in 1967 as a porter at Worcester State Hospital. From 1977 through 1982 he is listed as mechanical handyman at Worcester State Hospital. He was retired by 1985.

#### Scope and Content

The bulk of the collection is comprised of photographs and snapshots of the Alfred Jaynes family, and provide insight into the life and activities of Mr. Jaynes and family through much of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The photographs range from ca. 1900 to the 1980s, and include black and white prints, color prints in Kodacolor and Kodachrome, Polaroid prints in both color and black and white. Prints includes snapshots of various sizes, portrait photographs and group photographs up to 8x10 in. The subjects of most of the photographs are not identified. Topically, the collection includes individual and group prints, scenes, several prints of a car accident, many prints taken during military service in Korea, and other miscellaneous subjects.

The collection also includes clippings, notably the obituary of Mrs. Elizabeth Morse, active in local native American affairs. Other clippings relate to undated wedding announcements, and miscellaneous items.

The collection includes a Bible, King James version, inscribed to Alfred Jaynes.

#### Series Description

<u>Series 1</u>: Photographs. Includes color and black and white snapshots and photographic prints of individuals, groups, scenes, and other topics. Few subjects are identified by name. (229 items)

<u>Series 2</u>: Clippings. Includes clippings from local newspapers in regard to various weddings and the obituary of Mrs. Elizabeth Morse.

Series 3: Miscellaneous. Includes envelopes, copy of the Bible.
