Historical/Biographical Notes

Nancy Leland was born June 29, 1919 in Worcester. She was a graduate of Colby Junior College, the Juilliard School of Music, and received a Bachelor of Music degree from New England Conservatory in 1942. She was a pianist and a teacher. In 1943 she married Adolphe Joseph Schoepflin, a physician (orthopedic surgeon and medical administration) with the U. S. Army. Nancy Leland was a descendant of the Little, Henderson, and McLeish families on her paternal side; the Knight, Partridge, Rodgers, and Leland families on the maternal side. There were a significant number of physicians in the Leland line. Nancy Leland Schoepflin died in 1999.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises a family record of the ancestry of Nancy Leland and extensive genealogical notes, clippings related to activities of various family members, photographs (1860s-1990s) of family members, a diploma (1940s), clippings from Japanese newspapers relating to activities of Nancy Leland Schoepflin during her stay there, as well as her notes written in Japanese. The collection also includes published works of Worcester county and city history, a history of Clark University, and several pocket bibles from the 19th century.
