### Collection Information

Abstract : The Main Street Baptist Church, originally named Third Baptist Church, was organized in 1853, and a building erected and dedicated in 1856. The church operated until 1908, when (apparently) it became a Presbyterian Congregation.

### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

The Main Street Baptist Church was organized in 1853 as the Third Baptist Church. A church building was erected on Main Street in Worcester by 1855, and dedicated in 1856 by the Rev. Dr. Wayland of Providence, R.I. His son, Rev. H. L. Wayland, was minister of the church until 1861. Beginning about 1867, the church became known as Main Street Baptist Church, and seems to have adopted the name by 1888, although in 1906 it is referred to as Old First Baptist Church. From 1908 until 1988, the church (apparently same building) housed the First Presbyterian Church. After 1988 the building was home to Emanuel Baptist Church.

### **Scope and Content**

The collection includes pamphlets of sermons, programs, reports, etc. from 1854 until 1895, along with an envelope in which a pamphlet was mailed in 1854. The collection also includes a manuscript copy of a list of donors to the expense of establishing the church, March 1852.

### **Series Description**

**Series 1:** Pamphlets. Includes catalogs of books in Sabbath School library, sermons, yearbooks and manuals, religious writings.
