Historical/Biographical Notes

Walter Perry Bullard, grandfather of the donor, was employed at Fleischmann Co., manufacturers of yeast, at the company's Worcester facility around the early 1900s. Elizabeth Holliday, greataunt of the donor, was employed as a clerk in various departments in Worcester City Hall from the 1910s through the 1940s.

The Bullard family genealogy is traced to John Bullard, b. abt. 1485 in England. Family members settled in the Watertown Massachusetts area before 1639. The genealogy is traced through 17 generations, from the 1400s through 1980s.

The First Universalist Church was founded in Worcester in 1841, the older of the two Universalist churches in the city, and was in existence through the 1970s.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of photographs of Fleishmann Co. wagons and trucks, ca. 1900-1920; photographs of Elizabeth Holliday, 1935-1953; and an unidentified group photograph, ca. 1900. Also included is a Bullard family genealogy of the family line from ca. 1400s to the 1980s. Also included is a program of Sabbath School exercises at the Universalist church, December 25, 1856.

Series Description

<u>Series 1</u>: Photographs; including Fleischmann Co. delivery vehicles, Elizabeth Holliday, and an unknown group.

Series 2: Genealogy; Bullard family from ca. 1485 to 1980s.

Series 3: Program; Universalist Sabbath School exercises, 1856.
