Historical/Biographical Notes

Pullman-Standard Manufacturing Co., originally Pullman-Bradley, was established in Worcester ca. 1934 as manufacturer of rail passenger cars and related transportation products. The name was changed to Pullman-Standard in 1936. The company had a manufacturing facility in the Greendale section of Worcester. The company is no longer listed in Worcester after 1964.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of a set of blueprints and specifications for a 38 passenger trolley bus for Boston Elevated Railway, 1937.
