Historical/Biographical Notes

Samuel Elias Staples was born in Medway Village, May 19, 1822. The son of John and Mary Ann (Heath) Staples, and was one of the direct descendants of Abraham Staples one of the first founders of the town of Mendon, MA. In 1852 he moved to Worcester and entered the employ of T. & O. K. Earke, lumber dealers. He was a member of the Common Council in 1860 and of the school board from 1869 – 1871. His most important accomplishments were the founding of the Worcester County Musical Association and the Worcester Society of Antiquity. He married in 1844, Lucinda (Lovett). She died in 1883. They had four children. Samuel E. Staples died April 4, 1902.

One son, Samuel Frederick Staples was born in 1849 in Worcester, Massachusetts. His occupation prior to joining the 7th Calvary In January 1872 was a painter. He was a Corporal in Company I, 7th Calvary under Lt. Colonel George Armstrong Custer's command during the Battle of Little Bighorn June 25 and 26, 1876. He died June 25, 1876.
