#### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

Charles Pardon Stevens was born 1829 in Charlton, Mass., attended Worcester Academy after elementary education in Charlton. He went to California in 1849 following the discovery of gold, returning in the fall. He and his brother Daniel returned to California in 1850. After their return the brothers established a partnership, D. & C. P. Stevens, establishing a sash, door, and blinds business on Southbridge Street in Worcester. The brothers also dealt in real estate, and founded a grain and feed business. Charles Pardon Stevens died in 1885.

#### **Scope and Content**

The collection consists of a single quarter plate daguerreotype of Stevens, made during the California gold rush, ca. 1850, showing Stevens in a posed portrait with miner's clothing and equipment.
