#### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

Supernor family members Ethel, Earl, Eugene, Russell were students at Gates lane, Ludlow Street, and Webster Square Schools during the 1920s. The four children are shown on class photographs of the period. Ethel Supernor Parslow's father was with Walker Ice Co. in Worcester, her grandfather was with Coes Knife Co. during the 1920s.

#### **Scope and Content**

The collection consists of ten school class photographs taken between 1921 and 1929 showing members of the Supernor family, and three additional photographs of family members.
