## Collection Information

Abstract : Family histories and genealogies of Tyler and related families from late 18<sup>th</sup> century into the 20<sup>th</sup> century, along with photographs and ephemera collected by family members during the early to middle 20<sup>th</sup> century.

### Historical/Biographical Notes

The first family member of the Tyler family mentioned in the collection is Job Tilor (Tyler), born in 1620 and settled in Andover (deed refers to land near Town of Marlborough) and his descendants, notably the Rev. Albert Tyler, 1823-1912, of Oxford Mass. The collection comprises genealogical information of the Tyler family, as well as the Crane, Forrest, and other families related by marriage to the Tylers. Photographs, mostly daguerreotypes of Albert Tyler and his family, portray many of the family members during the period ca. 1850-1900.

Insight into family interests are indicated by the scrapbooks of art, poetry, clippings, etc., and by an extensive postcard collection of Worcester and Worcester County, ca. 1900-1930. Scrapbooks include extensive family histories of the Tyler and Crane families. Additional family genealogical information is inscribed in several bibles owned by family members.

The Tyler family is very large. The concentration of this collection is primarily on the Albert Tyler family of Oxford and their descendants.

### Scope and Content

The collection consists of Tyler family records, photographs, ephemera, etc., given to Worcester Historical Museum under the provisions of the will of Christine Crane in 2000. Included are some 60 postcards of Worcester and the region ca. 1900-1930, photographs (mostly daguerreotypes and tintypes) of family members, letters and memoranda relating to contents of the collection, commemorative covers including First Day of Issue cover of Clara Barton commemorative stamp with extra Clara Barton stamps. Also included are financial records of family members, ca. 1830s and 1870s; autograph books and diaries, ca. 1870s-1902; scrapbooks, including two scrapbooks of genealogical information; and miscellaneous records, including writings and sketches of Albert H. Tyler, ca. 1880, memorial book at the death of Walter D. Tyler, 1945, deed to land from Moses Tilor to Job Tilor situated near Marlborough, Mass., November 12, 1664. Published works include bibles, early 19<sup>th</sup> century, with genealogical information, early 19<sup>th</sup> century schoolbooks, and other published works.

The collection provides significant insight into the genealogy of the Tyler and related families, and activities of the family from the 17<sup>th</sup> century to the early 20<sup>th</sup> century.

The collection is arranged by form/format.
