<u>Abstract</u>: Photograph collection of U. S. Steel Corp. in Worcester, showing employees, activities, buildings, etc. Approximately 250 photographs were taken 1940s to 1960s, including many of construction relating to facilities expansion during the late 1950s.

Historical/Biographical Notes

The American Steel & Wire Division of United States Steel Corporation was the direct descendant of Ichabod Washburn, Wire Manufacturer, established in Grove Mill on Grove Street in 1834. It became Washburn & Moen in 1851. In 1899 Washburn & Moen joined with other Worcester wire-making companies to become American Steel & Wire Co. In 1901 the company became a subsidiary of United States Steel Corp. The facilities were consolidated from several sites in Worcester to the South Works, an extensive industrial area near Quinsigamond Village in 1943. During the 1940s the company employed some 4000 workers. In 1958, after the manufacture of steel was discontinued, employees numbered about 2300. By 1971 the company's presence in Worcester was represented only by the Electrical Cable Division, employing 500. The company ceased operations in Worcester in 1977.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises approximately 250 photographs of employees, activities, and buildings of United States Steel Co., including South Works, Cable Works, and other areas. Most of the photographs are 8 x 10 in., and were taken between 1940s and 1960s. Many show new construction in the late 1950s.
