Collection Information

Abstract: The Van Slett Advertising Company was established on Park Avenue in Worcester in 1940 by Francis A. Van Slett, and designed and manufactured signs for advertising and other purposes until Van Slett's retirement in the early 1990s. The collection is comprised of design drawings for a variety of signs for Worcester businesses, industries, and organizations; and financial records from the 1950s and 1960s.

Historical Information

The Van Slett Advertising Company, located on Park Avenue in Worcester, was established about 1940 (first appearance in City Directory) by Francis A. Van Slett. The company designed and manufactured signs of all types for regional businesses, industries, and other institutions, although advertising signs constituted the bulk of the business.

In 1961 Francis A. Van Slett purchased the assets of the Worcester Lunch Car Company, and established the Worcester Deluxe Diners Manufacturing Company. This company designed one diner and began construction, but ceased operations before the diner was completed.

The Van Slett Advertising Company continued operations until the retirement of Francis A. Van Slett in the early 1990s, when the business closed.

Scope and Content

The collection is comprised of some 18 design drawings of proposed signs for advertising and other purposes, along with a set of draft plans for building renovations. Proposed signs are all for local enterprises, and include signs for Wyman-Gordon Company, Salisbury Mansion, Harrington & Richardson Company, Clark University, Hahnemann Hospital, Girl Scouts of America, Worcester County Institution for Savings, Holy Cross College, Leicester Savings Bank, and others. Most items are undated, but dated items range from 1948 to 1988.

The collection also includes financial records of the company from the 1950s and 1960s, and a catalog of sign-making supplies.

The collection provides insight into the business of design and construction of advertising, and other signs, as well as providing information on the types of publicity used by local businesses, industries, and institutions. Sign styles can also be used as a dating technique for graphic documents.
