#### Historical/Biographical Notes

Members of the Whipple family have been supporters, members, at at various times officers and members of the Board of Directors of the Worcester Historical Museum. The collection represents personal family collections from the latter part of the 19<sup>th</sup> through early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries.

### **Scope and Content**

A significant part of the collection includes photographs, ca. 1870s—ca. 1900, and photographs of early 18<sup>th</sup> century prints of Worcester, made ca. 1890s. The collection also includes several amateur serial publications with articles written by local authors, printed in Worcester, ca. 1870s. Also included is a large collection of ephemera, including various theater programs, church bulletins, etc. from ca. 1880—ca. 1920, oversize prints, and miscellaneous items.

#### **Series Description**

Series 1: Photographs. Mostly 19<sup>th</sup> century photographs of Worcester, with photographs of earlier prints. 94 items.

<u>Series 2</u>: Serial Publications. 19<sup>th</sup> century Worcester amateur publications, with a few older Worcester newspapers. 40 items.

Series 3: Publications. Local authors and local organizational histories, ca. 1880s. 6 items.

Series 4: Ephemera. 19<sup>th</sup> century theater programs, 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century church newsletters, music, notices, broadsides, etc. 10 items.

Series 5: Prints. Birds-eye view of Worcester, early 19th century map of Worcester. 2 items.
