Collection Information

Abstract : Moses Wing was a silversmith who was born in Rochester, MA in 1760. He worked in Worcester as a silversmith from 1805 – 1809. Collection includes seven receipts for his work.

Historical/Biographical Notes

Moses Wing was born in Rochester, MA in 1706; son of Samuel and Joanna (Haskell) Wing. The family moved to Pine Meadow (later called Windsor Locks) in 1775. He first married Hannah, daughter of Samuel Denslow; she died in 1792. He married 2nd Huldah, daughter of Captain Martin Denslow. He built a shop on the end of the family lot. He was called a Goldsmith and made brass clocks, some of which are still excellent timekeepers, silver teaspoons, knee-buckles, shoe-buckles, etc. He was also a Major in the Revolutionary War. In partnership with Geer Terry for a while before dissolving in 1805. Removed to Worcester, MA, where he worked from 1805-1809. He died October 13, 1809 in Windsor, CT.

Scope and Content

The collection contains seven receipts and bills for various services rendered by Moses Wing.
