The Natural History Park and Camp was owned and operated by the Worcester Natural History Society. It was located on a tract of land near the north end and bordering on the shores of Lake Quinsigamond. The park included the summit and eastern slope of Wigwam Hill, and contains about 40 acres. The money to purchase the land (\$5,000) was given by Hon. Joseph H. Walker, and Thomas H. Dodge.
