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Collection Information

<u>Abstract</u>: Blueprints and other plans for Worcester Public School buildings document the construction and renovation of several middle 19th to early 20th century school buildings in Worcester, along with construction and renovation more recent school buildings. The plans illustrate school architecture and classroom amenities of the periods. Many buildings shown in the collection are now demolished or converted to other uses. Plans date from middle 19th to late 20th centuries.

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Historical/Biographical Notes

Millbury Street Schools No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3 were built in 1883, 1885, and 1892. Each was a two-story brick building; nine rooms in No. 1, and four rooms each in Nos. 2 and 3. The three buildings, along with Millbury Street School No. 4 (built 1898), were on Millbury Street at Cambridge Street on a single parcel of land. Late 19th century development in the area which coincided with industrial development in the South Worcester area caused the need for additional schools in this area.

Woodland Street Schools No. 1 and 2 were built in 1870 and 1881, 3 story and 2 story brick buildings. An addition was planned in 1957 and another in 1961. The buildings were demolished in the 1990s and replaced with a new school on the same site. The plans provide significant insight into the evolution of the important school location. New Woodland Street School, a two-story eight room brick building, was erected in 1898 at a location on Woodland Street not far from the older Woodland Street School. This school, also known as New Woodland Street Preparatory School was a 7th and 8th grade school with accelerated high school preparatory courses.

Abbott Street School was constructed in 1895 as an 8-room building serving eight grades. In 1905 the building was expanded to 12 rooms. The plans show the framing and floor plan arrangement of the original 1895 building and plans for the addition.

Chandler Street School was constructed in 1884 as a two-story brick school, with ten classrooms. Collection includes plans for various interior modifications which were done in 1917, 1929, and 1969. The building is no longer in existence.

Harlow Street School was constructed in 1897 as a two-story brick four-room school. In 1914 a two-story eight-room addition was built, tripling the capacity of the building.

Quinsigamond School No. 1 was built in 1870, a brick three-story school with eight classrooms. No. 2 was built in 1889, two-story brick building with 8 classrooms. No. 3 was built in 1899, also a brick three-story building with six classrooms. The original No. 1 was apparently demolished before the 1960s, and Nos. 2 and 3 renamed Nos. 1 and 2 respectively. The two buildings were rehabilitated in 1967, following some ten years of alterations and modifications to the buildings. Early site plans show the spatial relation of the three buildings.

Home Street School was constructed in 1902 as a six-room, three-story brick school. After 1910 the school is referred to in School Department records as Dix Street School No. 2, although it continued to be called Home Street School in the Department of Public Buildings records. See Sever Street School plans.

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Historical/Biographical, continued

Thomas Street School was constructed in 1850 as a 12-room, three-story brick structure. Interior alterations were done during the early 20th century to improve space utilization, heating and ventilation. The school is no longer in existence.

West Boylston Street School was constructed in 1902 as a brick, two-story four room schoolhouse. An addition in 1915 doubled the capacity with an additional 4 rooms. The school was located near Schoolhouse Pond, near Barber's Crossing on (old) West Boylston Street. An addition was proposed in 1949. The school is no longer in use.

Sever Street School was also constructed in 1902, a brick three-story six-room schoolhouse on Sever Street near Elm Park. The school is no longer in use. The school was designed by Barker & Nourse, the same architects that planned Home Street School, also constructed in 1902. The same plans were used for many elements of both buildings.

Vernon Hill School was constructed in the mid 1980s as an elementary school. Considerable exterior repair and renovation were carried out in 1998.

Norrback Avenue School was built as an elementary school in 1963/1964 in the Summit area of Worcester, at Malden Street and Norrback Avenue. The building has been replaced by a new school (1990s)

Bloomingdale School was built in 1896 as a two-story brick four-room school. An addition in 1916 added four additional classrooms. No longer used as a school, the building was sold in the 1990s and was converted to apartments. Bloomingdale School No. 2 was built in 1928, a two-story brick school with eight classrooms.

Lamartine Street School No. 1, No. 2, No. 3 were brick buildings with three, two, and two stories respectively. Numbers 1 and 3 had 12 classrooms each, number 2 had 8. The buildings were built in 1867 (No. 1), 1897 (No. 2), and 1912 (No. 3). None of the buildings are now in use. Lamartine Street School No. 3 also called Meade Street School.

Dix Street School was built as a three-story twelve-classroom brick building in 1867. Home Street School was built in 1902 on the rear of the same plot of land, and was later called Dix Street School No. 2. Schools at this site were discontinued around 1970. See also Home Street School.

Elizabeth Street School was built in 1893 as a brick two-story 12-room schoolhouse. Additions (ca. 1920s) enlarged the building to 16 rooms. In the 1970s the building was used as a media depot, industrial arts area, and special school by the School Department. The building was demolished around the mid 1980s.

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Historical/Biographical, continued

Downing Street School was built in 1891, a brick two-story twelve-room schoolhouse. The building has been renovated and is listed on the National Register of Historic Buildings.

Canterbury Street School No. 1 was built in 1876, No. 2 in 1898. Both were brick three-story buildings, No. 1 with 12 rooms, and No. 2 with six rooms. Canterbury Street Elementary School is still in use (2000). The first school on this site was called Adriatic Mills School, a wooden building with two rooms. This was replaced by Adriatic School, later replaced by Canterbury Street School No. 1, sometimes called Adriatic School.

Cambridge Street School No. 1 was built in 1870 as a three-story nine-room schoolhouse. It was enlarged in 1916 to fourteen rooms. Cambridge Street School No. 2 was built in 1891 as a two-story eight-room schoolhouse on the same plot of land. The schools were discontinued in the late 1970s.

Edgeworth Street School was built in 1870 as a three-story nine-room brick schoolhouse. An addition was built in 1908 expanding the building to 14 rooms. The building was in use as a school until the late 1970s.

East Kendall Street School was built in 1898 in the Belmont Hill area of Worcester. Originally a two-story eight-room school, it was enlarged in 1908 to 14 rooms. The school was discontinued in the early 1970s.

Winslow Street School was built in 1878 as a two-story four-room school, off Pleasant Street near Park Avenue. The school was enlarged to 10 rooms in 1880, then by mid-1880s to 14 rooms by conversion of attic space to four classrooms. Use of the building was discontinued in the late 1970s.

Gage Street School was built at a site on Gage Street near Shrewsbury Street in 1884 as a two-story ten-room brick school. The building was substantially enlarged in 1899 to a three-story 16 room school, and enlarged again in 1924 to 29 rooms. The school was in use until the late 1990s as a public school, and is now (2000) the Seven Hills Charter School.

Belmont Street School was originally a two-story ten-room school, built in 1871. Dates of enlargement of the building are not specified, but it is listed as a 15 room school in 1884, and by the 1920s was listed as three-story eighteen-room building. The building was demolished for construction of I-290 ca. 1970.

Burncoat Junior High School (Burncoat Middle School) was built in the middle 1950s in the northern part of the city to provide a school for grades 6 through 9. Previously students in this area attended elementary school through grade 8, then entered high school.

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Historical/Biographical, continued

Roosevelt School, also called Pine Hill Road School in some city documents, and also identified as Sunderland Road School on original plans, was built in 1918 as a single story six-room schoolhouse, wood construction with stucco exterior walls. A single story four-room addition was built in 1957. The building was in use as an elementary school into the 1990s.

Middlesex Avenue School was built in 1925, a two-story eight-room brick building near Lake Park. The building was in use as a school until the early 1980s. The site at present is an apartment building.

Upsala Street School was built in 1894 as a two-story eight-room schoolhouse in the rapidly growing Union Hill area of Worcester. The building was enlarged to 14 rooms in 1902, and again enlarged in 1924 to 22 rooms. The school was in use into the early 1980s.

Indian Hill School on Ararat Street in the northern part of Worcester was built in 1924 as a two-story eight-room elementary school to replace the existing one-room North Worcester School and portable buildings. The building was discontinued as a public school around 1980, and sold to Salter Secretarial School.

Andover Street School was built in 1914, a six-room two-story elementary school near Barber's Crossing in the northern part of Worcester. It was discontinued as a school around 1980.

Malvern Road School was built as a four-room two-story brick elementary school in 1896 at the corner of Southbridge Street and Malvern Road. An addition in 1907 doubled the size to eight rooms. The school was in use as an elementary school until around 1980.

Blithewood Avenue School was built in 1895 as a wood frame two-story four-room elementary school. It is described in 1924 as a brick building (brick faced wooden construction). The school, on Blithewood Avenue at Massasoit Road was in use until around 1980.

Lee Street School was built in 1885 as a two-story four-room elementary school. An addition in 1927 doubled the capacity to eight rooms. The building was used as a school until around 1980, then used by the Worcester Health Department for some years. The building is now demolished.

Jamesville School was a two-room single story schoolhouse built in 1887 in the Jamesville section of Worcester. In 1903 the building was moved to a site on Clover Street. The school housed grades 1 through 6 in two rooms with one portable classroom. The school was out of use around 1933.

Adams Square School was a two-story four-room brick elementary school built in 1887. An addition was built in 1894 adding an additional four rooms. The school was in use until ca. 1960 when it was demolished for construction of I-290.

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May Street School was built in 1927 as a two-story eight-room schoolhouse, on May Street near Chandler Street. The building is still in use as a school (2000).

Providence Street School No. 1 was built in 1866 as a four-story eight-room schoolhouse. Providence Street School No. 2 was built in 1896, a two-story eight-room building. The buildings were demolished in the late 1950s for I-290 construction.

Ledge Street School No. 1 was built in 1870 as a three-story twelve-room schoolhouse. No. 2 was built in 1886, a two-story six-room building, which was enlarged in 1910 to 14 rooms. The school was in use until demolished in the late 1950s for I-290 construction.

North High School was built in 1889 as a two-story ten-room high school on Salisbury Street near Lincoln Square. A three-story addition built in 1915 increased the capacity to 28 rooms. North High School Annex occupied the building (1929 addition) formerly used by Commerce High School after the middle 1970s. The building was discontinued as a school in the early 1980s, and is now an apartment complex.

South High School was built in 1900/1901, a three-story 20 room building, off Main Street near Clark University. A three-story addition was built in 1931, with gymnasium, locker rooms, and additional classrooms. The building was in use as a high school until ca. 1980. It is now Goddard School of Science and technology.

Classical High School, originally named English High School, was built in 1891 as a four-story 22 room high school on Irving Street near Pleasant Street, replacing an earlier high school on the same site. The building was in use as a high school until the late 1960s. It now houses the school administration offices.

High School of Commerce (originally named Classical High School) consisted of a three-story 20 room building on Walnut Street. A second building was constructed in 1913 providing an additional 21 classrooms. An addition was built in 1929 with an additional 36 classrooms. The school was discontinued in the late 1960s, and the buildings demolished.

Gates Lane School was built in 1898 as a two-story four-room elementary school. It was enlarged to 12 rooms in 1903, and again enlarged in 1922 and 1925 to 18 rooms. In 1993 much of the existing building was demolished, and a new school constructed on the site, incorporating some parts of the earlier building. The school is still in use as an elementary school.

Bancroft School, a private school established in the early 1900s, relocated to a new facility constructed in 1994 on Shore Drive near the north shore of Indian Lake. Assumption College is a private institution established in the early 1900s under the care of the Assumptionist fathers. The original site of the college is now Quinsigamond Community College.

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Scope and Content

The collection includes new boiler location plans for Millbury Street School No. 1, 1916; and plans for alterations to the boys' toilets and ventilation system, 1921; floor plans for Millbury Street School No. 2, n.d., along with set of plans for heating/ventilation, 1914; floor plans, framing plans, exterior elevations of Millbury Street School No. 3 (n.d.), with additional heating/ventilation plans in pencil and plans for boys' toilets.

Also included are plans for an addition to Woodland Street School, 1959, and site plans, 1995; with new building construction plans of 1961, incorporating parts of existing buildings. Included also are plans for renovations to roof, heating and ventilating systems, windows, and other improvements at New Woodland Street School, 1937 and 1938. Included are plans for the original 1870 school, along with various alterations throughout its life.

Abbott Street School plans show the floor plans of the 1895 structure, as originally built as a two-story eight-room school, along with detailed framing plans and elevations. Also includes plans for 1905 addition.

Chandler Street School plans show various alterations to the building and heating system carried out in 1917, 1929, and 1969. 1917 plans for electric lighting show placement of both gas and electric lights in the building.

Harlow Street School plans show alterations to the boys' and girls' rooms, 1914; and complete plans for an eight-room addition to the original four-room school in 1914.

Quinsigamond School Nos. 1 & 2 plans include major rehabilitation plans for the two buildings, 1967, as well as plans for modifications and alterations between 1956 and 1966. Early plans show all three original buildings, site plans, etc.

Home Street School plans show 1901 construction plans of this school. Additional floor plans are undated. An additional earlier plan may be a school proposed for this site ca. 1890. See also Sever Street School.

Thomas Street School plans show interior alterations, alterations to toilets, and several proposals for heating/ventilation improvements between ca. 1894 and ca. 1910s.

West Boylston Street School plans include plans for the 1915 addition, another proposed addition in 1949, and heating, ventilating, and other alterations between 1914-1967.

Sever Street School plans include primarily 1902 construction plans for the school. Many of the plans for Home Street School were used in the design of this school, and are included. Includes specifications.

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Scope and Content, continued

Vernon Hill School plans consist of a set of plans for exterior envelope repair to the structure in 1998.

Norrback Avenue School plans consist of the original plans for the building drawn in 1963, and include floor plans, elevations, heating and ventilating plans, electrical plans, etc.

Bloomingdale School plans consist of plans for the original construction of the building in 1896, plans for the addition of 1916, and various plans for alterations from ca. 1900 to ca. 1980. Also included are floor plans for Bloomingdale School No. 2, built in 1928.

Lamartine Street School plans include alterations to the three buildings, late 19th to late 20th centuries, heating/ventilating system improvements, floor plans for new construction and alterations; toilet alterations and improvements, 1920s; etc.

Dix Street School plans include heating and ventilation plans of 1907, plot plan of the school area, and alterations to doors, 1967. See also Home Street School.

Elizabeth Street School plans include various interior alterations (ca. 1960s) and plans for addition (ca. 1920s).

Downing Street School plans are comprised of the original plans for the school, built in 1891, in ink on cloth.

Canterbury Street School plans include floor plans and elevations for Canterbury Street School No. 1 (ca. 1875) and No. 2 (ca. 1898). Also includes plans of interior alterations to both buildings from ca. 1900 to ca. 1960s.

Cambridge Street School plans include building plans for Cambridge Street School No. 2, 1890; plot plans, and plans for interior alterations, 1927-1967. 1967 plan also shows interior alterations at Indian Hill School.

Edgeworth Street School plans are primarily comprised of building plans, heating/ventilating plans, and related plans for the 1908 addition to the building.

East Kendall Street School plans include floor plans and heating/ventilation plans for the original building, ca. 1897; as well as plans for the 1908 addition.

Winslow Street School plans include all aspects of the ca. 1880 addition, as well as several proposed heating and ventilating plans for the building as configured in the 1890s.

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Scope and Content, continued

Gage Street School plans include plans for the 1924 addition, demolition and renovation plans of 1959, details of urinals (ca. 1899), and other interior alterations (1920s).

Belmont Street School plans are comprised of heating/ventilating plans, electrical plans, both undated; improvements to girls' sanitary, 1905, and other miscellaneous plans, 1907-1920.

Burncoat Middle School plans consist of a set of plans for Phase 2 of heating system replacement, February 1997.

Roosevelt School plans include plans and amended plans for the 1918 building, and plans for the 1957 addition, with plans ca. 1920s and 1950s relating to septic system.

Middlesex Avenue School plans consist of oil burner installation plans, 1967, oil burner replacement plans, 1980, and a plot plan, 1961.

Upsala Street School plans include plans for the 1924 addition, and interior alterations and modifications 1960s-1970s.

Indian Hill School plans consist of plans for the 1924 building, and various interior alterations to toilet rooms, heating system, and basement, and plot plans of the school area, 1950s-1970s.

Andover Street School plans consist of plot plans of the school area, and door alterations and boiler room modifications ca. 1966.

Malvern Road School plans include a site plan, plans for incinerator and new boiler, 1970s; toilet alterations, 1970s; and interior alterations, including alterations to Oxford Street School, 1960s.

Blithewood Avenue School plans consist of a plot plan of the school area, and a plan for incinerator in the boiler room, 1970.

Lee Street School plans include a plot plan of the school area, and alterations to the toilet rooms, 1960s-1970s.

Jamesville School plans consist of a plan for a privy at the rear of the school plot, n.d.

Adams Square School plans consist of a detailed plan of part of the boiler room, 1955.

May Street School plans consist of a plot plan of the area, 1963.

Providence Street School plans consist of a plot plan of the Posner Square area, showing the school and fire station, 1926.

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Scope and Content, continued

Ledge Street School plans consist of a plot plan showing location of buildings on lot, with construction dates and other data, 1926.

North High School plans include plot plans of the main school on Salisbury Street and North High Annex on Walnut Street, and plans of several interior alterations, 1950s-1970s.

South High School plans consist of a single plan of interior alterations, 1969, with plans for alterations to New Woodland Street School included on sheet.

Classical (English) High School plans consist of floor plans showing electric outlets, switches, etc., ca. 1900.

High School of Commerce plans include various interior alterations, 1910s to 1930s; plans for the 1929 addition, including complete set of plans; and 1960s alterations to the 1929 building for use as North High School Annex.

Gates Lane School plans include plans for the 1898 schoolhouse, the 1903 addition, the 1922 and 1925 additions, and various interior alterations, 1930s – 1970s.

New Gates Lane School plans include site plan, with demolition of existing building, architectural plans, and structural plans, 1993.

Multiple School Building Plans include one sheet showing fire alarm control panels on several school buildings, also one sheet showing interior renovations at several schools, ca. 1970. Site plans, 1993, show various schools and placement of portable buildings.

Bancroft School plans consist of a plot plan for new facility on Shore Drive near Indian Lake, 1994.

Assumption College plans consist of plans and elevations for the 1904 building and the 1921 wing, located on West Boylston Street north of the Greendale section of Worcester.
