### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

Black Ice Publishers were located at 100 Prescott Street, in Worcester, apparently in space rented from Washburn-Garfield, valve manufacturers at that site. There are no references to the company and it is assumed that it was a very small operation, lasting about 12 years. Other than postcards, no other publications are known at this time.

### **Scope and Content**

Postcards published by Black Ice Publishers of Worcester, Mass., between 1971 and 1983. Postcards are halftone photomechanical prints of photographs taken by B. A. King, and are of various scenes, mostly outside of Worcester.
