Historical/Biographical Notes

J. Ernest Brierly was born in Auburn in 1879. He spent his childhood in the Worcester area. He studied art at the Worcester Art Museum and later in New York and Philadelphia. He spent some time as a feature columnist at the Worcester Telegram and Gazette before becoming a

portrait painter in Chicago. It was in Worcester that he began his career of recording this country's landmarks with a series called "Worcester of Long Ago." The stock market crash in 1929 and the subsequent depression ended his business. He went to Spain, Italy and England and painted historic buildings and sites before joining the New York World Telegram. It was while there that he began a nostalgic series entitled, "Streets of New York" beginning in 1939. In 1958 he joined the Long Island Press and drew and edited the nostalgic feature "Long Island Long Ago." Mr. Brierly also edited and drew historic features for the Telegram and Gazette never forgetting where he came from. He died in November 1967 at the age of 88.
