Historical/Biographical Notes

Broadsides as an advertising medium have been known for centuries. Broadsides, handbills, circulars proliferated during the 19th century with the rapid growth of Worcester, a result of industrialization and immigration. The broadside and related formats was an inexpensive and fast method to publicize events, businesses, products in a manner to reach large numbers of people in short times. The small broadsides in this collection are more properly called handbills or circulars, and were designed to be posted, passed from person to person, or delivered.

Scope and Content

The collection of broadsides, circulars, handbills represents a broad range of Worcester and Worcester events, businesses, products, etc., mostly 19th century. The collection is arranged topically.
