Abstract : The collection contains four manuscript boxes of correspondence, building

specifications, price quotations, blue prints, sketches of landscaping, receipts, notes, trade catalogs, and other construction records all concerning the Bullock House at 70 Cedar Street. Most of the correspondences is from Francis H. Dewey (1856-1933), Father of Mrs. Rockwood H. Bullock (- 1971)

Historical/Biographical Notes

70 Cedar Street was built in 1908 by Mr and Mrs Francis H. Dewey for their daughter, Elizabeth B. Dewey who had married Rockwood H. Bullock, son of Mr and Mrs Alexander H . Bullock in 1905. Rockwood Hoar Bullock was born in Princeton, MA on August 21, 1881. He graduated from Harvard in 1903 and worked first for Worcester Consolidated Street Railway from 1903 – 1907, when he opened a general insurance office. They had four children; Augustus George, Francis D., Elizabeth C. and Mary C. Rockwood died August 28, 1958.
