Abstract : Collection includes information relating to the Chamberlin family of Worcester, Massachusetts. Collection contains diaries, correspondences, poetry books, financial records, legal records, business records, and land agreements of the Chamberlin family.

Historical/Biographical Notes

Henry Harmon Chamberlin (January 7, 1813 – January 11, 1899) was born in Hardwick, Massachusetts. He moved to Worcester, Massachusetts with his family in 1822. He apprenticed as a clerk in Daniel Heywood's general store in 1827 and in 1835 opened a store of his own on the future site of Mechanics Hall. The business was reorganized in 1840 as a dry goods store under the name of H.H. Chamberlin & Co. Eventually the firm evolved into the Barnard, Sumner & Putnam Co. Chamberlin however, left the business in 1855 to manufacture cotton and woolen goods in Oxford, Massachusetts. He later was a manufacturers' agent for a number of woolen goods companies. His later years were spent speculating in real estate – mostly in the south part of Worcester and improving his home on Hammond Street. Chamberlin was a prominent figure in local politics, as well as a strong supporter of the anti-slavery movement and a member of the Free Soil Party.

On August 19, 1839, Henry Harmon Chamberlin married Charlotte R. Clarke (August 18, 1820 – February 28, 1905), who was from Uxbridge, Massachusetts. They had three children, Charles Henry (June 5, 1840 – September 1, 1841), Henry Harmon Junior (June 15, 1845 – July 11, 1864) and William Wiggelsworth (ca. 1850 - ?).

William Wiggelsworth Chamberlin married Elizabeth Ferguson Paine (October 13, 1848 – May 2, 1935) on June 12, 1872. They had one child, Henry Harmon Chamberlin (August 6, 1873 – July 10, 1951). W.W. Chamberlin went missing in July of 1880 in Boston, Massachusetts. The cause of his disappearance was unknown.

Henry Harmon Chamberlin (H.H. Chamberlin) was the grandson of Henry Harmon Chamberlin and Charlotte R. Clarke. He was a Harvard Graduate in 1895, and taught English there from 1869 – 1897. He rose to prominence prior to World War I for supporting military preparedness. After the war, he became active in the plight of war ravaged Italy. Although he was never directly involved in politics, H.H. Chamberlin, a Republican, wrote many letters and editorials to politicians and newspapers, asserting his political beliefs. H.H. Chamberlin was the initiator in the 1930's of a movement which saw a series of soccer matches played between Worcester, Massachusetts, USA and Worcester, England. H.H. Chamberlin was well known for his poetry, especially for his translations of the work of Theocritus, the Greek poet. He was a member of many literary, poetry and social clubs.

H.H. Chamberlin married Armida Theresa Zoraide Moja of Lugano, Switzerland on June 1, 1907. They had one son, Harmon Paine Chamberlin (June 4, 1908 – May 1979). Little information can be found about Armida, although throughout her marriage to H.H. Chamberlin she was a landlord for many properties in Worcester, MA and Nantucket, MA.

Scope and Content

This collection has been divided into five distinct series. The first being Henry Harmon and Charlotte R. (Clark) Chamberlin, centering on their Real Estate Business dealings with a Real Estate Record Book, also including personal correspondences, family papers, membership certificates and 2 poetry books and 2 diaries. An detailed listing of Real Estate Documents (Deeds, Warranties, Bonds, etc.) can be found in Appendix A.

The second series is the personal correspondence of Elizabeth Ferguson (Paine) Chamberlin, between her and family members.

The third series is Henry Harmon Chamberlin, focusing on his passion with literary matters. Included are literary works, written by others and by him, during his childhood, Harvard College Essays, and works written as an adult (as well as copies of printed articles). There are 8 Log and Journals that catalogue his trip to Europe, as well as poetry and literary notebooks. There is also a large sub-series on correspondences, including literary matters, newspaper editorials, letters written to politicians, and other miscellaneous correspondences. H.H. Chamberlin's Certificate of Merit in Genealogy is also included. There are 2 Appendixes for this series – Appendix B: Harvard Essays and Appendix C: Correspondences.

The fourth series is Armida Theresa (Zoraide) Chamberlin and focuses primarily on her Real Estate Dealings in Worcester and Nantucket, Massachusetts. Appendix D is a detailed listing of these dealings. Also included are her correspondences, detailed listing in Appendix E.

The final series in for Henry Harmon and Armida Theresa (Zoraide) Chamberlin. This series focuses on the financial documents of them as a married couple, as well as any miscellaneous items (envelopes) found in the collection.
