Abstract: James Marcus Drennan was a Civil War veteran, attaining the rank of Captain with the 25th Regiment, Massachusetts Volunteer Infantry. Following the war he pursued a police career, serving as City Marshal of Worcester, with the Massachusetts State Police, as a Deputy Sheriff of Worcester County, as Police Chief of Worcester, and finally as Worcester County probation officer. The Drennan Papers collections illustrate events from military activities through his police career.

Biographical Information

James Marcus Drennan was born in Ireland in 1834, son of a farmer who relocated to Rutland, Massachusetts. He was educated in the Worcester public schools and at Leicester Academy, and learned the trade of a carpenter. Prior to the Civil War he was engaged in contracting.

Drennan enlisted in the 25th Regiment, Massachusetts Volunteer Infantry, and served throughout the Civil War, reaching the rank of Captain. The regiment took part in nine battles and numerous other skirmishes and engagements. After the war he remained active in the state militia, attaining command and the rank of Colonel in the 10th Massachusetts.

Soon after his return from war he was appointed Deputy Marshal of Worcester, later Marshal (Chief of Police), a position he held until 1872. In that year he joined the Massachusetts state police and remained until 1879. He again was appointed City Marshall and held that position until 1883, when he was appointed Deputy Sheriff, remaining in that position until 1897. For a three year period, 1897-1899, he again served as Chief of Police of Worcester. From 1900 until his death in 1904 he was Probation Officer for Worcester County.

Drennan was a charter member of the George H. Ward Post, No. 10, Grand Army of the Republic. He was also Founder and first President of the Lakeview Improvement Society, and was active in many other public affairs.

Drennan married Sarah Leseur in 1856, and was father of five children.

Scope and Content

The Drennan Papers Record Group 1998.57, one of three collections of papers of James Marcus Drennan, illustrate primarily aspects of Drennan's activities in military service during the Civil War and various aspects of his police career, along with genealogical information about Drennan and his wife, nee Sarah Leseur, and documents relating to Drennan's application for a pension from his military service.

Genealogical records and family histories illustrate the descent of Sarah Leseur Drennan from the royal Tudor family in England, along with related and collateral lines, and information on the Drennan line from Ireland.

Military records illustrate the activities of Drennan with the 25th Regiment M.V.I. during the Civil War, post-war reunions, and the processes required to qualify for veteran's pensions during the post-Civil War years.

Police records illustrate Drennan's activities from the late 1860s into the early 20th century, and are highlighted with documents relating to the Grafton Bank Robbery in 1870. Includes are numerous other investigations carried out by Drennan in his various police functions, as well as manuals and official documents illustrating police methods and practices of the latter half of the 19th century. Diaries, memorandum books, and letters all contain a mixture of personal and police business, giving insight into Drennan's methods of record keeping and investigating.

Also included in this record group are canceled checks, passbooks, invoices and receipts relating to Drennan's personal, as well as professional life. Miscellaneous items and ephemera illustrate primarily Drennan's travels and activities in pursuit of various police investigations and other business.

Includes police department manuals, notes re criminal investigations and crimes, photographs (chiefly criminals), clippings, warrants, extradition documents and related materials, and letters, memoranda, and other material relating to the Grafton Bank robbery. Divided topically into six subseries:

 - Subseries 3. Other police investigations/activities.
 - Subseries 4. Legal documents.
