Abstract : Collection contains a twenty page account book the recorded the rents Earl received for tenements at 29 Salem Street, 184 Austin Street as well as other locations. Each entry lists the name of the renter, the date the rent was paid and the amount of each month's rent. The volume is arranged chronologically starting in October 1884 continuing through June 1889.

Amos R. Earl (1830 – 1893) was born in Sutton, MA the son of George and Martha Earl. As an adult, he moved to Worcester and soon owned a stable in the rear of 72 Mechanic Street. He also owned and rented out tenements throughout the city. He lived at 5 Mason Street in Worcester.
