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Collection Information

Abstract : Collection includes information relating to the various organizations that were housed in G.A.R. Hall on Pearl Street. Organizations include; American Legion, USS Old Ironsides Post 423, Woman's Relief Corp, World War Mothers of New England, American War Mothers, and Daughters of Union Veterans of the Civil War. Historical/Biographical Notes

Doctor B.F. Stephenson founded the Grand Army of the Republic in 1866 in Decatur, Ill. The organization was founded as a fraternal group for Union veterans of the Civil War. The group quickly spread, and by the end of the 1860s, there were GAR posts across the nation. The group,

under the weak leadership of Stephenson, nearly died in the early 1870s, but new leadership revived it in 1875. By 1890, the GAR had 490,000 veterans, and it was a driving force in politics and law. Five US Presidents were members of the GAR, and dozens of northern politicians were members. In 1949, the six remaining GAR members closed the organization for good.

The Worcester branch of the Grand Army of the Republic-Post 10-was named in honor of George H. Ward. Ward was a Lieutenant Colonel in the 15th Massachusetts Volunteer Infantry Regiment, and he was wounded in action at Balls Bluff in Leesburg, Va., on October 21, 1862. His left foot was amputated as a result of those wounds. He was recalled to duty and died on July 3, 1864 from wounds he had received the day before at the battle of Gettysburg. The branch was organized on April 13, 1867 in Brinley Hall. There were eleven charter members. The post moved to Waldo Hall, then to a post on Walnut Street (which later burned down), and then took up temporary residence in the Odd Fellows Hall on Pearl Street. The group moved into its final home, the former Bull Mansion on Pearl Street, in 1912. This hall was said to be the finest GAR hall in the nation. For several years, Post 10 was the largest in the nation, and its members included soldiers who had fought in every major battle both on land and on the sea.

Weapon manufacturer Daniel B. Wesson built the building that is currently called GAR Hall in 1876 as gift to his daughter and son-in-law, Dr. and Mrs. George Bull. The building cost \$125,000 to build and was designed by prominent Architect Calvert Vaux. In 1903, the house was sold to Warren D. Hobbs, who presented it to his daughter, who lived there until 1913. The house was then purchased by the Grand Army of the Republic for \$21,600. The building would house Post 10 until 1932, when the depleted ranks of the post decided to deed the building to the city. The house has remained relatively unused for seventy years until it was purchased by Mitchell Terricciano in November of 2003. He plans to relocate it.

Scope and Content

Collection includes information relating to the various organizations that were housed in G.A.R. Hall on Pearl Street.
