Historical/Biographical Notes

John M. Goodhue was born in Massachusetts and was appointed as the Captain of the 11th U.S. Infantry on May 14, 1861. He was then appointed as Major of the 23rd U.S. Infantry on November 23, 1868 and transferred to the 11th U.S. Infantry on December 24, 1868. Later, he was moved to the 21st U.S. Infantry on March 15, 1869. Goodhue was finally unassigned on March 26, 1869 and mustered out January 1, 1871.
