Historical/Biographical Notes

John Williams Gould (1840-1915), a son of Rufus and Mary Henry Gould was born in New Braintree, Massachusetts. He taught school in Ware and Hubbardston, Massachusetts before joining the Union Army in 1861. After his discharge in 1862 he moved to Westboro to study dentistry with his Uncle, Samuel G. Henry. Gould opened an office in Oakham in 1864 but moved to Worcester in 1865, where he remained until his death in 1915. He married Nellie Melissa Muzzy (1855-1959) and the couple had six children.

George H. Gould (1827-1899), brother of John Williams Gould, attended Monson Academy and graduated from Amherst College in 1850 and from Union Theological Seminary in Andover, Massachusetts in 1853. He traveled extensively in Europe with John B. Gough, the temperance leader. On his return to the United States, Gould became pastor of a church in New York and later became pastor of the Plymouth Congregational Church in Worcester. He also preached at the Union Church in Worcester and others as his health would permit.

Edwin Sprague Gould (1844-), a brother of John Williams Gould and George H. Gould, enlisted in the 51st Massachusetts Volunteers in 1862 and was discharged in 1863. He attended Phillip's Andover Academy, but gave up his studies due to his eye problems. He worked for several different newspapers throughout New England before he entered the Hartford Theological Seminary. Gould graduated in 1872 and became pastor of different churches in Providence, Rhode Island, New Haven, Connecticut, and West Brookfield and Athol Massachusetts.

Mary Earle Gould (-1972), a daughter of John Williams and Nellie Muzzy Gould was a graduate of Wheaton College. She was a piano and organ teacher for 30 years and was also a noted local author. Her works on antiques included Early American Wooden Ware, The Early American House, and more than 600 articles in newspapers and magazines.

Scope and Content

The Collection contains one manuscript box with six folders which houses all of the papers and documents concerning the Gould family. There is also one oversized manuscript folder that houses three high school diplomas of Gould family members.
