Abstract : Collection includes over 100 letters written by Mander “Allie” Maynard to various family members throughout hi service during the Civil War. ### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

Mander Allie Maynard was born in Massachusetts in 1842. He served in Company F, 7<sup>th</sup> RI during the Civil War. In January 1863, he became ill with typhoid fever as was removed to

Portsmouth Grove, the Rhode Island convalescent camp. He was mustered in the fall of 1862 and mustered out in June of 1865. After the war, he went to work for the Boston and Worcester Railroad. He married first a Sarah Maynard and they had three children; Lottie, Miron and Fred. He married again in 1909 a Luthia S. He remained with the railroad for 32 years retiring in 1897. For a period of time he served as president of the Worcester Society of Antiquity. He died January 3, 1913.

### **Scope and Content**

Collection includes over 100 letters written by Mander "Allie" Maynard to various family members throughout his service during the Civil War. The letters include information about several hospitals he recovered in and several battles he witnessed and/or participated in including the Battle of the Crater and Fort Stedman.
