Historical/Biographical Notes

Dr. Edwin T. Olson was a practicing optometrist in Worcester since 1930. He received his license to practice in 1926 after graduating from the Massachusetts College of Optometry. For his 35 years of practice, he worked at the same location, Plymouth Building on Main St. in Worcester.

Dr. Olson was a member of a vast number of organizations including the Salem Square Covenant Church, the Vasa Order, the Worcester Foundation for Experimental Biology and the National Aeronautics Association. He was also on the executive board for the Worcester Historical Society, an auditor for the Worcester Swedish Charitable Association, and president of the National College Student Foundation as well as many other organizations.

Dr. Olson was the donor of a wildlife management and aquatic biology building in 1955. This was given for the Worcester Science Museums' Daniels School of Forestry in Rutland. The building is in memory of his father, the late John Olson. Dr. Olson passed away on October 6, 1965 at the age of 61. He left behind a wife and a cousin.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of slides relating to various New England scenes that paralleled Dr. Olson's life. Scenes include trees, brooks, a few village streets, and even people dating back to the early 1900's.
