Abstract : Fred Josiah Proctor was owner of Proctor Lumber Company from the 1930s until 1949, when it was sold to Baker Lumber Company of Worcester. The collection consists of items from Proctor's personal effects.

### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

Fred Josiah Proctor and his brother George Ellis Proctor bought an existing coal and lumber business in Northborough in the 1930s, and operated it as Proctor Lumber Company until 1949, when the company was sold to Baker Lumber Company of Worcester. The company before its dissolution did considerable business with Sawyer Lumber Company of Worcester.

### **Scope and Content**

The collection consists of personal effects from Fred Josiah Proctor, and includes Worcester postcards, ca. 1920s; advertising wrapper for Marcellus Roper Company of Worcester, ca. 1900s; and a metal salve container from N.R. Scott & Sons, Apothecaries, of Worcester, ca. 1900.
