Historical/Biographical Notes

Edward Tilly Raymond, son of Tilly and Mercy R. Raymond, was born in Worcester August 8, 1844. He was educated in the public schools and at Highland Military Academy. In 1861 at the age of seventeen, he entered the Union army as sergeant of Company K, 35th Massachusetts. In August of 1862, he was commissioned first lieutenant in the 36th Regiment, as was promoted to be captain and major. He participated in 35 sieges and battles, including Wilderness, Spottsylvania and Cold Harbor. After the war he was appointed superintendent of bonded warehouses for the port of Boston and Charlestown, and remained there until 1882. He was admitted to the bar in 1880, and in January 1882, entered upon his duties as clerk of the Central District Court. He died in 1913.

Scope and Content
