### Historical/Biographical Notes

Frederick G. Stiles was born in Worcester, June 19, 1825, son of Charles and Lucy Stiles, in a house on Mechanics Street. Stiles became an apprentice to carriage and sign maker and made that his business until 1891. His shop was on North Foster Street at Cyprus Street. When old enough, he became a member of the Light Infantry. at the outbreak of the Civil War Maj. Stiles raised E company which, with other Worcester County companies, was assigned to the 42<sup>nd</sup> Regiment. Frederick G. Stiles died at his home on May 27, 1908 at the age of 82.
