Harvard University was established in Cambridge, Mass. in 1636, the oldest college in the United States. During past centuries the university was also called College in Cambridge, or University in Cambridge. The university today is one of the most prestigious in the world.

The collection consists of one item, a program of “Order of performances for exhibition, Thursday, August 23, 1821.” Program includes orations, dialogs, discussions, and disputations in Latin, Greek, and English, and provides insight into university education of the early 1800s.
