Historical/Biographical Notes

Born in Boston, Massachusetts in 1724, Daniel Waldo Sr. was a merchant who moved from Boston to Worcester in 1782 to establish a retail store. A competitor for Stephen Salisbury, he married into the family, marrying Rebecca Salisbury and having 10 children with her, 5 of which (Martha, Daniel, Elizabeth, Sarah, and Rebecca) survived him. He passed the business on to his son, Daniel Waldo Jr. in 1792, and died in 1808.

Daniel Waldo Jr., son of Daniel Waldo Sr., was born in Boston in on January 20, 1763 and moved with his father to Worcester in 1782 to eventually join him as a business partner in their import retail store. After his father retired he extended his business and shared with Steven Salisbury in supplying demand for foreign articles, before relinquishing his store to his two assistants, George Rice and Henry Miller in 1821. From there, he went on to be the President of the Worcester bank in 1804, and then the President of the Worcester County Institution for Savings in 1828, both titles he retained for the remainder of his life. He was also president of the Agricultural and Horticultural Society, founder of the Worcester Fire Society, and was 3 times elected into a seat in the Senate of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. He lived with his 3 maiden sisters, Rebecca (Sept 22, 1771-June 19, 1840), Elizabeth (November 24, 1765-August 28, 1845), and Sarah (February 22, 1767-March 19, 1957). All four of them entered a pact together never to marry. Daniel Waldo Jr. died at the age of 82 in 1845.

Daniel Waldo Sr.'s eldest daughter, Martha (Sept 14, 1761-March 28, 1828), married Levi Lincoln Esq, an eminent lawyer who for some time was Attorney General of the United and afterwards Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Their daughter, Martha Lincoln, went on to marry Leonard Moody Parker, and then their daughter Elizabeth Waldo (May 9, 1817-March 25 1891) married Francis Harrison Kinnicutt (April 27, 1812 – September 15, 1885). Francis Kinnicutt was the estate agent for the Waldo estate after Daniel Waldo Jr.'s death.

Scope and Content

Collection contains the papers of Daniel Waldo Sr. and Jr., as well as papers relating to the Waldo estate after the time of his death, from the Kinnicutt family papers (accession numbers 1983.79 and 1973.11, folders 1983.79 – 7, 1973.11, and 1983.79.8 are rehoused within this Waldo collection). Papers include deeds (land deeds, mortgage deeds, right of way deeds, deeds to pews, and deeds to the use of wells, to name a few), bonds, writs, land plans, ledger pages, one committee correlation, notes, letters, wills, genealogy records, and several newspaper clippings.
