Historical/Biographical Notes

Dr. Samuel B. Woodward was a prominent and well thought of physician and businessman in Worcester in the late 1800's to the mid-1940's. He was the son of Samuel B. Woodward, who was also a distinguished businessman, and grandson of Dr. Samuel B. Woodward, likewise, a renowned physician in Worcester. Dr. Woodward graduated from Harvard College and Harvard Medical School. He interned at Boston City Hospital, then studied in Europe prior to returning to Worcester. He began a general practice and became a surgical specialist. In Worcester he was consulting and visiting surgeon at St. Vincent's and City Hospitals. He was on the board of Trustees of Worcester State Hospital. He served on the medical and surgical staff of Memorial Hospital, was head of the surgical department and served as chairman of its board. Though he had no children, he was concerned for the well being of the children of Worcester, and was president of the Worcester Chapter of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children. He was involved in numerous other medical societies. After retiring from 40 years in the medical profession, he became president of Worcester County Institution for Savings, a position he held for 25 years. He was involved in numerous civic organizations and often gave addresses. Being interested in the issues of his day, he also regularly wrote letters to the editors of both local and Boston papers, as well as to local and state politicians.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of the personal and business papers of Dr. Samuel Woodward and records of some of the organizations of which he was a member. Most of the papers are correspondence, both to and from him and speeches he gave to various organizations. There are letters to his father from his trip to Europe, after graduating from medical school and before going into practice. He wrote a History of Medicine in Worcester from 1635 to 1888. A journal of his patients and the operation he performed is part of the collection.

Also included are papers about the women's suffrage movement, the League of Women Voters and the Women's Centennial Congress.
