Historical/Biographical Notes

Philip Davis began his newspaper, "Jewish Chronicle-Leader", in 1980. It was the offspring of a 60 year tradition. The Jewish Civic Leader, founded in 1926, and the Jewish Chronicle, started

in 1977. Davis' Mar-Len Publications bought the Civic Leader in 1980 and merged the two papers into the Chronicle-Leader. The Jewish Chronicle-Leader brought together the Civic Leader's folksier, social news with the Chronicle's local feature stories and reports from the news services such as the Jewish Telegraphic Agency and the Israel Tourist Office. The newspaper's feature stories localized major issues in Jewish life. The newspaper wrote about such topics as Jewish mysticism, homosexuality, conversion and intermarriage.

Scope and Content

The collection contains audiocassettes recorded by Phil Davis of the Worcester Chronicle. These cassettes cover a variety of topic relating to Worcester's Jewish Community. Topics include; the elderly, interviews with Rabbis, women's' issues, Jewish Federation, community involvement, Israel and interviews with prominent Jewish authors.
