Historical Background

The Worcester City Hospital School of Nursing was established at the hospital in 1883 to provide a two-year course of study to young men and women wishing to become nurses. During the first years, the training program consisted of one year's practical work on the hospital wards with an experienced nurse, and a second year of practical home nursing at various shut-in's residences. Nursing as a profession was relatively unsophisticated during the late 19th century, and duties of a nurse dealt with housekeeping as much as with care of a patient. Through the early years the program was strengthened and modified with the addition of more formalized theoretical study and increased ward experience. During the early 20th century the program was also strengthened by increasing it to a three year course of study. During this period the first entrance requirements to the school were established – the successful completion of one year of high school.

During the next decades the course of study became more sophisticated as the medical profession became more knowledgeable about diseases, causes, and cures. By 1928 a high school diploma was required for admission to the school, and the three-year course of study became standardized.

Worcester City Hospital School of Nursing was one of the first nursing schools in the area to seek accreditation of its course of study, as a guarantee that its graduates were competent. Accreditation was achieved in 1952. The training programs of the recent decades have become increasingly complex, keeping pace with the rapid changes in the medical profession as a whole.

The final class to graduate from Worcester City Hospital School of Nursing entered in 1989, and graduated in 1992, the year of the hospital's closing. Changes in the nursing profession as the medical field has become more complex and sophisticated have reduced the demand for three-year Registered Nurses, and increased the need for more new nurses with a B.S. degree in Nursing.

Scope and Content

Worcester City Hospital School of Nursing Records provide insight into the changes in the nursing profession between the year of the school's founding, 1883, and its closing in 1992. The Records include instructional notes from the late 19th and early 20th century, student and nurses' records from the same time period, class photographs from various classes between 1890-1992, scrapbooks of school activities between 1958-1979, scrapbook of Worcester news and personalities between ca. 1890-ca. 1910, including historical information about politics, the new City Hall, Mechanics Hall, etc. The collection also includes videorecordings of school and hospital events, alumni information, and ephemera.

The records range from 1889 to 1992, with the bulk of the collection consisting of records and other materials through the 1930s. More recent information in the collection is primarily in the form of clippings and videocassette tapes.

Series Description

Series 1: School of Nursing Papers, including information on various aspects of student life, courses of study, admission requirements, records, etc. Divided into five subseries as follows:
