One of the earliest city directories, the 1829 directory includes residents and businesses on Lincoln Square, Main Street, Washington Square, Summer, School, Thomas, Central, Pleasant, Front, South, Green, Grafton, Middle, and Prospect Streets. The population of Worcester in 1829 was about 4,000.
