### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

The 36<sup>th</sup> Regiment MA Volunteer Militia was composed of eight companies from Worcester County. The regiment was mustered into 3 years service at Camp Wool in Worcester and left there September 2, 1862. The regiment participated in the Battle of Fredericksburg, Wilderness, Spottsylvania, and Petersburg. The Regiment returned to Worcester in June 1865 to be mustered out of service.
